My husband, Jim and I built our home in the Campanas neighborhood of CCRC in 2017. While not permanently living here until August 2023, we were in our home on a monthly basis and engaged in the community and our neighborhood the degree possible.

OCCUPATION

I have had the privilege of serving 54 years in the varying aspects of Health Care delivery. My career began in the US Army Nurse Corp providing care and leadership in Pediatrics. I was honorably discharged in 1973 as a Captain.

Following my service in the Army, I held various leadership roles in health care the most recent of which was President/CEO of Henry Ford Macomb Hospital. During my tenure with Henry Ford Health, our enterprise grew from an annual budget of \$263M to \$700M. Our specialty clinical programming became recognized regionally, statewide and nationally. In addition, and based on demonstrated community need, we expanded the footprint of the organization with a \$300M tower project completed in the first quarter of 2023. The remarkable staff (medical, employees and volunteers) became recognized within the community as genuinely committed to community health and wellness with outreach activities within the many diverse aspects of the communities we were privileged to serve.

PREVIOUS COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION OR NON-PROFIT EXPERIENCE:

Representing the mission and vision of Henry Ford Macomb Hospital was in part fulfilled through personal service to the community and outside of the role I held. Henry Ford Macomb was successful because of the trust we engendered from those we served and how we represented and honored the communities we served. I was purposeful in the selection of the boards that I was privileged to serve throughout my career. Their mission/vision needed to align with identified community benefit needs and the mission/vision of HFM.

The executive committee worked most closely with the Executive Director to provide support and direction to ensure that annual budgets were developed and managed, contracts were negotiated and overseen, volunteers and staff were engaged and led, committee direction and oversight were overseen. For some organizations philanthropy was crucial to the continued mission of the organization, for instance, Advancing Macomb and the Southeastern Michigan American Red Cross.
